



## CWCI Beach Driver Training Course Instructions

The Beach Driver Training videos will introduce you to some of the animals that use Florida's beaches, and teach you how to reduce the chances that they will be injured or killed by vehicles you operate. FWC's Coastal Wildlife Conservation Initiative (CWCI) developed this online training series primarily for service drivers (such as lifeguards, emergency responders, or maintenance personnel) in northeast Florida. Click “Create New Account” on right (unless you already have an account), and fill in the required fields. Once in the course (BD101), in order to get a completion certificate, you will need to:

- View “Beach Driver Training - Part 1: Sea Turtles (VIDEO)”
- View “Beach Driver Training - Part 2: Shorebirds (VIDEO)”
- Take the quiz, and receive at least an 80% correct score. Be sure to answer all 13 questions (4 pages) before clicking “Submit and finish.”
- Answer the 3 NOAA partner survey questions.
- Then you can click the link for “Certificate of Completion” (at bottom of page) to view, print, or save your certificate!
