**Beaverdam Creek Wildlife
Management Area**

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) of the State of Florida, under Article IV, Section 9 of the Florida Constitution and the rules and regulations of the Commission, hereby establishes the Beaverdam Creek Wildlife Management Area in Liberty County, Florida, with the following described area:

The legal description for the Beaverdam Creek Wildlife Management Area (WMA) is contained in a letter from the Northwest Florida Water Management District dated June 11, 2011 requesting the land be established as a WMA. Legal descriptions for all properties within this request are located in Central Files of the FWC.

Request to establish land: 1,317 Acres **New for Feb. 2012**

All lands comprising approximately 1,317 acres and posted as a Wildlife Management Area.

Authority: Article IV, Section 9, Florida Constitution

Effective Date: July 1, 2012


