Nassau Wildlife Management Area

The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission of the State of Florida, under Article IV, Section 9 of the Florida Constitution and the rules and regulations of the Commission, hereby disestablishes the Nassau Wildlife Management Area in Nassau County, Florida, with the following described area:

All lands comprising approximately 8,155 acres are withdrawn as a Wildlife Management Area.


