For purpose of verifying total income for restricted species endorsement



Income Requirement for Restricted Species Endorsement

Pursuant to 68B-2.006, Florida Administrative Code, a Restricted Species endorsement shall be issued to a person who is at least 16 years of age certifying that over 25 percent or \$5,000 of his or her income, whichever is less, is attributable to the sale of saltwater products. However, if at least 50 percent of the annual income is derived from charter fishing, the person must certify that at least \$2,500 of the income is attributable to the sale of saltwater products. For persons age 62 or older, the income requirement is \$2,500 attributable to the sale of saltwater products. Such income attribution must apply to at least 1 of the last 3 years. **For the purpose of this section, "income" means that income that is attributable to work, employment, entrepreneurship, pensions, retirement benefits, and social security benefits.**
